1. Registration Costs

- 💰 Church Registration: \$150 (one-time, non-refundable fee)

Registration covers accommodations at camps or grants to host churches providing billeting. It also includes costs related to the event, such as meals (breakfasts, lunches, and some suppers), fun activities, rallies, and programming.

2. Pre-Event Planning & Preparation

Consider budgeting for costs related to planning meetings, training, and preparations.

Planning & Training Costs

Youth Group Meetings: Snacks, printing, or travel expenses for regular planning sessions.

Leadership Meetings: Costs for meals or materials for meetings with your team.

Fundraisers: Costs for fundraisers if they will not be recouped



3. Expenses During the Event

During the event, your group will have different cost categories to consider.

Food

Sreakfasts and lunches are included in registration.

- Some group suppers are included.
- **Don't miss PEI's famous dairy bars!** Be sure to budget for a stop (or more) at one of the Island's many beloved ice cream spots.
- **!** Your team may need to plan for a couple of additional meals (e.g., eating out or preparing food for your group). We also encourage students to bring their own spending money for fun and incidentals.

Tip: Ask your congregation if they can donate snacks, drinks, or meal support!

Transportation

Travel to PEI: Consider ferry, bridge tolls, gas, or rental costs.

Eccal Transportation: Will you need to rent vans or reimburse drivers for gas?

Important Note:

- Van rentals can be difficult to secure. Book rental vehicles as soon as possible to avoid last-minute issues.
- **Check your insurance and policies** for driving students. Ensure your drivers are approved under your church's insurance policy.

Neighboring Project Tools & Supplies

- **Project Materials:** Will you need to buy **paint, tools, craft supplies, sports equipment, or other materials** for your service projects?
- Health & Safety: Do you need PPE supplies (masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, etc.) for certain ministry settings?

- A team-building activity (bowling, beach trip, mini-golf, etc.)

- Costs for the free evening (if you choose to plan an outing instead of the one planned by Tidal Impact)

Host Family Gift

Leaving a small gift for Host Families (billets) is a Tidal Impact tradition! And a great way to say thank you! Consider encouraging any students being billeted to bring a small gift to say thank you to their host families. Whether a bag of nice coffee, or a gift card for a family ice cream outing, a small under \$20 investment goes a long way for our incredible host families!
